- 6. The Board unanimously agreed to send a request to the State Board of Elections requesting a reduction of hours for the upcoming November General Election. The board all signed the letter and Director Garland told them she would send it in to the state tomorrow. Secretary Crisp made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Member Colvard made a second. Vote was unanimous.*
