



**AMENDMENT 10 TO STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION OF
GRAHAM COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA
15 APRIL 2020**

By unanimous vote on a motion by Commissioner Orr, seconded by Commissioner Nelson in a duly called and noticed meeting of the Board of Commissioners on the 15th day of April 2020, the Board adopts the following Resolution as an Amendment to the Declaration of Emergency:

BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Graham County Emergency Management Ordinance as adopted on the 17th, 19th and 21st day of March 2020, the Emergency Declaration of the 19th of March and the Amendments thereto are hereby ratified in their entirety and incorporated by reference herein.
2. In addition to the other prohibitions and restrictions authorized in § 8 of the Ordinance the following paragraph is added:
(10) The local Emergency Planning Committee is authorized TO formulate a policy whereby agents of the County may waive any restriction against entry into the County by persons who are not residents, landowners or essential workers who do not have a permit for entry if in their discretion allowing entry serves to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the public. The agents are charged with issuing a temporary paper permit to the person(s), and documenting its issuance so that the temporary entry may be monitored. The temporary permit shall include the name and address of the holder, the date of the issuance, the purpose for temporary admission, the duration of the visit and the location where the holder may be found.
3. This Resolution is immediately enforceable by those charged with enforcing the Ordinances, Resolutions of the County and the directives of the Board of County Commissioners, its Chairman and the County Manager.
