

Polling Place Buffer Zone for Graham County Polling Places

The Following is a list of Graham County polling places and a description of each buffer zone in which Election Day electioneering is permitted. Buffer zones are designated in accordance with G.S. 163-166.4(a), by the County Board of Elections. Where practical set limit of the zone is 50 feet from the door of the entrance to the voting place, measured when the door is closed, but in no event is the limit at more than 50 feet or less than 25 feet.

The poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with signs and yellow tape.

Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the front of door

| Tapoco Precinct | Located at 4497 Tapoco Rd. Tapoco Fire Hall
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the front door
To the entrance of the polling place. |
